



Bikeworks Freelance E-scooter Lead Instructor

Location: Various locations across London (most e-scooter training taking place in West London - Kensington & Chelsea, Hammersmith & Fulham, Ealing)

Main role: Lead Instructor - delivering e-scooter training sessions

Commitment: Up to 20 weekend days between March and September 2022 (some weekday work might also be available).

Qualification Requirements: Level 2 award in cycling instruction - provisional or full. You will have experience delivering cycle training to a range of groups.

Pay: £110 per 5.5 hour day (£20/hour) (Freelance role)

Deadline: Friday 25th February (applications will be considered as they come in, ahead of training on 1st March 2022, and recruitment is ongoing for cycle instructor roles).

N.B. Bikeworks would like to encourage women instructors to apply. In addition to open sessions, we are looking for women instructors to lead a series of women's only training sessions - both for the general public, and for community groups.

Bikeworks is an East London community-evolved social enterprise that uses cycling as a tool to tackle social, economic and environmental challenges across London. As a not-for-profit social enterprise, we reinvest our profits back into our community programmes and address the inequalities being experienced by people most likely to be left behind through the delivery of our inclusive cycling clubs, accredited employment and training programme, public bike maintenance, cycle training for children and adults, and much, much more.

Bikeworks delivers a range of cycle training across multiple London Boroughs. We have developed a new E-scooter National Standard to complement the rollout of e-scooter rental trials in London and other cities and have been delivering e-scooter training since 2020.

The Bikeworks Micromobility project is being delivered in partnership with TIER Mobility - one of London's e-scooter operators. The training aims to educate the public about the use of e-scooters, while upskilling users to feel confident travelling by e-scooter.



The role is perfect for someone who is a qualified cycle instructor, with experience delivering cycle training to different groups of people. The instructor will be responsible for delivering the Bikeworks e-scooter curriculum to the public. You should have an interest in promoting active travel and supporting others to feel confident cycling/e-scooting as a means of transport.

On a typical day you will deliver two 2-hour e-scooter training sessions, according to the Bikeworks session plan and national standards (modelled on the Bikeability standards). You will be responsible for dynamic risk assessments, delivering the training to pre-registered attendees, and recording participant attendance and achievement.
